CANCELLATION

Cancellations will be accepted by the organizing secretariat strictly within Friday, 3rd August 2012 entitling the registrant to a 80% reimbursement of the fee paid. ABSTRACT

The Abstract submission for Poster or Oral Communication must be done, through the Congress web site platform, by Saturday, 30th June 2012.

The Congress Scientific Committee will communicate the accepted poster and oral communication list by Monday, 30th July 2012. Authors will be informed by a mail, to the email address they have written in the website platform during the abstract submission phase.

To submit a poster at least one name of the authors must be registered at the Congress.
