The 2008 Call

- First Call of New Health Programme
- 2008 budget for calls: 47,8M€
 - 28,5M€ (Projects) + 9,3 M€ (Tenders) + 2,3M€ (Joint actions)+ 2,3M€ (Operating grants) + 0,7M€ (Conferences) + 2,3M€ (International Organisations), etc
- New financial mechanisms:
 - Operating grants
 - Conference grants
 - Joint actions
- Changed rules for co-financing

New financial mechanisms and funding opportunities in 2008

To ensure appropriate participation in the [Second Programme of Community action in the field of Health \(2008-13\)](#) and fulfilment of all the programme objectives, a wider variety of financing mechanisms are offered.

Both the Programme and its [Work Plan for 2008](#) foresee financial contributions for specific actions ('grants for an action') and support to the functioning of particular bodies or specialized networks ('operating grants'). The actions may include typical projects but also the organisation of conferences.

The financial contributions may, where appropriate, include joint financing by the Community and one or more Member states or by the Community and the competent authorities of other participating countries.

Therefore, the 2008 financing mechanisms include:

- [cofinancing of projects](#) intended to achieve a Programme objective (call for project proposals)
- [cofinancing of the operating costs of non-governmental organisations or specialised networks \(operating grants\)](#)

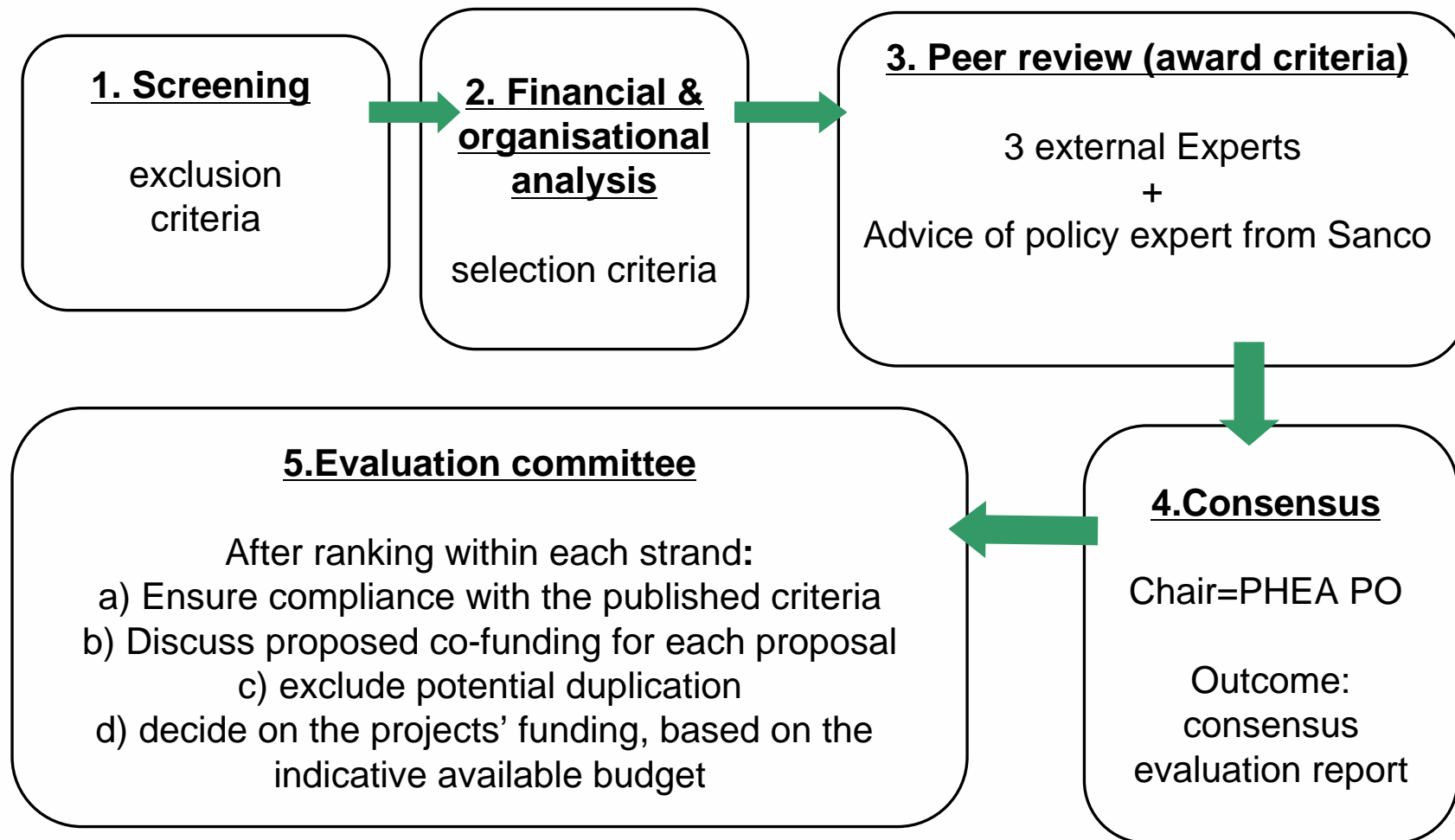

This call for expressions of interest was launched on 09/02/2008 to establish a list of experts for support activities in connection with the 2008 - 2013 Health programme. These activities consist in reviewing project proposals submitted under annual calls for proposals, monitoring or evaluating funded projects, and other tasks related to the implementation of the Programme ([link to OJ](#)).

Individuals interested in submitting their application are invited to read the text of the Call published in the Supplement to the Official Journal nr. S 28 of 09.02.0081, and to register via this site. The site has been designed for a quick registration and eventual updating. Data entry should not take more than fifteen minutes. You will also be asked to add your CV. All files are mandatory. Early registration is welcomed.

The personal data collected in the context of the present call will be processed in accordance with the Regulation (EC) n° 45/2001 of European Parliament and of Council from 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies on the free movement of such data.

The operational deadline for submission of candidatures for this year's exercise is 9 June 2008, while the call remains open until 2011.
